Certification Process


Upon registration, you will be enrolled in the **Prolog User Certification course** on learn.trimble.com. Your course enrollment will be valid for 90 days from activation.

The certification program consists of two types of validations:

- 1. **Multiple Choice Exams:** You will be required to answer approximately 77 multiple choice questions. The passing score is 80%.
- 2. **Hands-On Exams:** This portion is in a format of case studies in order to demonstrate your product knowledge; you will enter settings and data following a project scenario.

Getting Started

There are two ways to begin the certification process:

- 1. Register for a qualified training session and receive automatic enrollment into the Certification course, upon training completion (Certification Cost is <u>Free</u> with the purchase of a training course.)
 - a. Visit Learn.Trimble.com.
 - b. Create an account or log on.
 - c. Navigate to the Menu | Course Catalog.
 - d. In the Search field, type Prolog.
 - e. Click on the selected product course tile to begin the registration process.
 - Qualified courses are Prolog Introduction or Prolog Manager Essentials, Prolog Converge Essentials and Prolog Mobile Introduction.
- 2. If you are already a Prolog expert, you can purchase Prolog Certification Course without enrolling in a training course. (Cost: \$700.)
 - a. Visit Learn.Trimble.com.
 - b. Create an account or log on.
 - c. Navigate to the Menu | Course Catalog.
 - d. In the **Search** field, type **Prolog User Certification**.
 - e. Click on the selected product Certification tile to begin the registration process.

Cost

- Free of charge for Trimble qualified training classes attendees
- \$700 for general registration
- \$140 for renewals when updated version is offered
- \$160 re-activation fee for expired accounts
